Scope

- **Employment information**: Details from your resume such as employment history, educational qualifications, professional memberships, and accreditations.
- References: Information from your nominated referees.
- Sensitive information: Health information, immigration status, or criminal records, when required for service provision or legal compliance.

How We Collect Your Personal Information

Where possible, we collect information directly from you with your consent. This occurs through:

- Application processes for contract services.
- Communications such as telephone calls, emails, or website forms.
- Website interactions, which may use cookies to enhance your experience without tracking or recording personal details.

We may also collect information from third parties, including:

- Recruitment agencies and related service providers.
- Referees, clients, or government entities.

Where third-party collection is necessary, we ensure they provide protections equivalent to our own before any disclosure of personal information.
